Managing Director's Report

The RABP Managers have been meeting with City Engineer weekly to ensure

communication with the City stays consistent after the retirement of Executive Director

Cindy Solomon.

Kennedy Landscaping was hired to plant the downtown planters and the elevated Train

Station Plaza planters. They have been continuing general maintenance of these areas.

New Business

Culture Crawl as a one day arts event cannot happen this year due to the pandemic. We are

marking the month of September with a few activities. The *Best of the Culture Crawl Reel*

Short Film Festival will play one short film prior to the UCPAC's Movies Under the Stars on

Fridays in September. We will host the Culture Crawl *Art Selfie Stroll*, the community will take a selfie photo with ten works of art throughout the City and submit all ten photos to enter into a drawing for a gift certificate to Rahway businesses. Chalk will be placed outside before the movies at the UCPAC and at the Cherry Street Alley for the *Culture Crawl Community Art Fun*. There will be PPE and all will be encouraged to wipe down the supplies before and after use.

The RA+BP is exploring several City Beautifications plans. Purchasing new artistic bike racks to be placed throughout the City, replant the Train Station Plaza's elevated planters and add a new large sculpture, and add more Yarn Art in the Cherry Street alleyway.

The RA+BP is working with the Seton Hall Research and Marketing class. The focus of the research is to determine how to engage the residents in the apartment complexes with the businesses of Rahway.

In meetings with the City Engineer, the RA+BP is developing a five year plan for large streetscape projects.

Danni Newbury entered the meeting at 6:51pm.

Starting September 21st, the RA+BP will employ a maintenance person, who will focus on maintaining the cleanliness of the downtown area. It was suggested that a uniform be created so it is clear that this is an employee of the City and the RA+BP.

The RA+BP is participating in regular Business Recovery meetings with the City Engineer and the Director of the Rec Center, for Phase 2 Business Recovery plans.

Financials

The Managing Director reviewed the financials and the amended budget of \$250,000.

Update from the City

Councilperson Danni Newbury,on behalf of the City, commended the RA+BP for their continued commitment to serving businesses. Rahway is supporting businesses in ways

that other cities and towns are not.

Other Business

Creative Rahway for Education meetings will be continuing in the fall.

Matt Dobrowloski commented that the Rahway real estate market is extremely active and prices are escalating. The rental market is also very active.

Councilperson Joanna Miles entered at 7:08pm.

Miles reported that the *Spanktown Splash* canoe race is this Saturday and the *Tapas Trail* was very successful and received many good reviews.
